ASSUMPTION OF THE RISK AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY RELATING TO CORONAVIRUS/COVID-19: This Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19 is an amendment to the Activity Waiver between YOON'S MARTIAL ARTS (hereinafter referred to as "the Club") and Buyer and Student(s) listed below. It is not meant to supplant the Activity Waiver. All terms and conditions of the Activity Waiver remain in full force.

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, state, and local governments and federal and state health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, prohibited the congregation of groups of people.

The Club has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, the Club cannot guarantee that Buyer or their Student(s) will not become infected with COVID-19. Further, attending the Club could increase Buyer's risk and Student(s)' risk of contracting COVID-19.

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that Buyer and Student(s) may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending the Club and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at the Club may result from the actions or omissions, of myself (the Buyer), the Student(s), and others, including, but not limited to, Club employees, volunteers, and program participants and their families.

I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to Student(s) or myself (Buyer), including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death, illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind (including attorney's fees, court costs, and disbursements), that Buyer or Student(s) may experience or incur in connection with Student(s)' attendance at the Club or participation in Club programming ("Claims"). On my behalf, and on behalf of Student(s), I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless the Club, its employees, agents, and representatives, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes any Claims based on the actions or omissions of the Club, its employees, agents, and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in any Club program. I understand that Yoon's Martial Arts is a Martial Arts School and NOT a daycare/tutoring center. Their intent is to teach martial arts physical and philosophical character building skills. I hereby give permission for the applicant(s) to participate in all program activities and agree to release Yoon's Martial Arts, its employees, and staff from all liability arising from any accident/harm/injury by the participation of my child(ren) in the program stated above. Parent/legal guardian understands that accidents and/or injuries could occur during activities and is willing to accept any and all risks involved with having their child/children attend any Program at Yoon's Martial Arts. By way of copy of this form, I authorize the staff and employees of Yoon's Martial Arts to obtain medical/hospital treatment for the above participant in the event of an emergency. The undersigned for the purpose of enjoying the benefits of instruction agrees to the below conditions and agrees to pay fees as described in the payment agreement. It is understood and agreed that any tuition/fees/payments should not be returned to the enrollee/parent/guardian for any reason. I willingly agree to obey the instructions in all ways, and it is understood and agreed that this Club shall not be liable for any damages or injuries from lessons. The enrollee understands that there is a risk of personal injury involved in said course of instruction and with this knowledge agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Club from all losses caused by accident or injury to the enrollee or to third persons who may be enrollees by the Club, in the event that either the enrollee or said third person is injured in any way during the proper performance and execution of martial arts instruction. Because of the physical demands of martial arts instruction, enrollee understands that he or she must be in good physical condition to participate in said instruction and hereby certifies that he or she is in good physical condition. Student Rules For Parents And Students To Go Over

- ☐ Students must wear a Yoon's Summer Camp t-shirt and pants/shorts that are comfortable to exercise in.
- ☐ Students must wear socks every day and shoes must be worn when going to the bathroom.
- ☐ **Proper healthy hygiene must be maintained daily (trimmed nails, clean feet, and mindful of one's body odor).**
- ☐ Students must keep their hands and feet to themselves at all times.
- ☐ No abusive or inappropriate language is allowed.
- ☐ Accidents and all injuries should be reported to the staff immediately.
- ☐ Students may only leave with an authorized adult. A valid ID is required.
- ☐ No cellphones are allowed to be out unless it is being used for an emergency or with permission.
- ☐ No dangling or excessive jewelry.
- ☐ Yoon's Martial Arts and the staff are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please have names written on belongings to prevent this.
- ☐ **Students who do not meet self-discipline standards will be unable to participate in activities and/or will be dismissed from the program.**

Program Policy: Please read carefully and initial to indicate understanding of our program policy.

- Initial Here: _____ 1. We emphasize to parents that we are a MARTIAL ARTS school and not a practicing day care center. All students that are a part of our program are expected to uphold the Five Tenets of Taekwondo: Courtesy, Integrity, Perseverance, Self-Control, and Indomitable Spirit. Students that are a part of our camps and programs are expected to participate in martial arts classes unless excused by a parent or doctor.
- Initial Here: _____ 2. I understand that all payments must be made on Friday before the start of the week or by the start of the week on Monday. Any payments received after Monday will incur a \$10.00 late fee (no exceptions). Students will lose their spot if payments are not made on time.
- Initial Here: _____ 3. I understand that there are no refunds made on any payments (registration, t-shirts, weekly dues, field trips, etc.), time attended, and weeks paid in advance.
- Initial Here: _____ 4. I understand that field trips are tentative but also understand that I will be charged an additional fee if added on to the week my child is in attendance.
- Initial Here: _____ 5. I understand that selected weeks must be paid for regardless of attendance. Space is reserved for selected weeks and parents are responsible to pay the weekly fee in its entirety. There are no exceptions to this policy due to the limited number of spots available in camp each week.

- Initial Here: _____ 8. I understand that if my child's temperature reading is above normal, he/she will be asked to stay home for the day. Students will also be sent home if they show visual signs of being ill. (Please do not bring your child to camp if they are not feeling well/sick.)
